# **RECYCLING PROGRAM REGULATIONS**

## (Attachment I)

These regulations will govern the Township of Connellsville Recycling Program as stated in Ordinance 2019-1 Township of Connellsville Recycling Ordinance.

## 1. Separation of Recyclables by Residents and Storage and Collection:

The following materials are designated as recyclables for the Connellsville Township Recycling Program: clear glass, colored glass, aluminum, tin, steel, bimetallic cans, plastics and leaf waste. These are to be source separated as follows:

- A. Leaf Waste
- B. Clear glass, colored glass, aluminum cans, tin, steel or bimetallic cans, plastics can be comingled.

All glass and aluminum, tin, steel bimetallic cans shall be properly cleaned by the resident. Metal rings and caps must be removed from glass.

Recyclables will be placed at curbside for collection on days designated by the Township.

# 2. Separation of Recyclables by Multi-Family Housing Properties and Storage and Collection.

All recyclables, separation and cleaning are defined in Section 1 above.

The section allows an owner, landlord or agent of an owner or landlord of multi-family housing properties to comply with the requirements of Act 101 by establishing a collection system for recyclable materials at each property. The collection system must include suitable containers for collection and sorting materials, easily accessible locations for the containers, and written instructions to the occupants concerning use and the availability of the collection system. Owners, landlords and their agents who comply with this section shall not be liable for the noncompliance of occupants of their buildings.

# **3.** Separation of Recyclables by Commercial, Municipal and Institutional Establishments and at Community Activities and Storage Collection:

The following materials are designated as recyclables for the Township of Connellsville Recycling Program: aluminum, tin, steel, bimetallic cans, plastic, clear glass, colored glass, and leaf waste. These are to be source separated following the guidelines in Section 1.

An annual report must be provided to the Township on forms to be provided, containing recycled items and weights.

# 4. Separation and collection of Leaf Waste:

Leaf waste will be placed at curbside for collection on days designated by the Township as per Section V B. of Ordinance 2019-1.

#### 5. Public Education Program

Connellsville Township will conduct an education program where periodically tips and recycling information will be given to the public. Methods which will be utilized to inform the public of recycling will include the Township website, leaflets, and public meetings.

### 6. Changes to the Regulations:

Changes to the recycling program regulations will require approval from the governing body (administrative decision, vote at public meeting, resolution etc. – no ordinance change is needed). Public notice and notification to all affected parties will be required in advance of any program changes.
