AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CONNELLSVILLE, FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION II (a) (ADMINISTRATION) OF ORDINANCE NO. 2019-3, ALSO KNOWN AS THE TOWNSHIP OF CONNELLSVILLE GARBAGE ORDINANCE

IT IS HEREBY ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Connellsville Township, Fayette County, as follows:

SECTION I. REPEALER

This Ordinance hereby repeals Section II (a), Administration, of Ordinance No. 2019-3, also known as the Township of Connellsville Garbage Ordinance.

SECTION II. WILL READ AS FOLLOWS:

All refuse accumulated in Connellsville Township shall be collected, conveyed and disposed of by the Collector, and the cost of such service shall be paid to the collector in amounts determined by contract between the Supervisors and the Collector; notwithstanding the fact that the property owner may or may not be living on the subject property, all property owners shall be liable to the Township of Connellsville for the cost of collection from each dwelling, multiple dwellings, apartments, commercial, industrial, or any type of structure or parts thereof within the Township.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.
